

Discussion Questions - Psalm 3

1. Read Psalm 3. King David's son, Absalom, had organized a conspiracy to kill his father and assume the throne (2 Sam. 15-17). David had to flee the palace and while his enemies were hunting for him he wrote Psalm 3. Discuss any key points concerning David's method in dealing with this terrible trial.
2. Read Psalm 3:5 again. Discuss how it was possible for David to sleep despite the incredible anxiety he must have felt.
3. Read Psalm 3:6 again. Discuss why David didn't fear the great number of people who were conspiring against him?. (Isaiah 8:12-13). How can Christians not be afraid of those who might put them to death? (e.g. Daniel 3:12-18).
