## 2. Worldly Measures. (4:11-17)

Result in:

• Judging Others. (v. 11-12)

James 4:11-12 – "Do not speak against one another, brethren. He who speaks against a brother, or judges his brother, speaks against the law, and judges the law ... There is only one Lawgiver and Judge, the One who is able to save and to destroy; but who are you who judge your neighbor?"

• Wrong Planning. (v. 13-15)

James 4:13-15 - "Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow, we shall go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit ... Instead, you ought to say, 'If the Lord wills, we shall live and also do this or that.'"

• Arrogance & Boasting. (v. 16)

<u>James 4:16</u> - "But as it is, you boast in your arrogance; all such boasting is evil."

• Not Doing What is Right. (v. 17)

James 4:17 - "Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do, and does not do it, to him it is sin."
