Discussion on Genesis 20

1. Abraham's "half-truth" ("half-lie") to Abimelech in Genesis 20:1-2 is a repeat of his deception to Pharaoh in Genesis 12:13-17, even though Abraham had been walking with the Lord for twenty-five years. What lessons can we learn from these accounts (1 Corinthians 10:12)? What is the result of self-confidence/pride (Proverbs 16:18)?

3. Read Genesis 20:6, if Abimelech had committed adultery with Sarah wouldn't his sin be against Sarah and Abraham? Explain (Psalm 51:17).

2. Read Genesis 20:9-10. Here Abimelech, a pagan king, is chastising Abraham, the man of God. What should be the Christian's response be to the world's rebuke (Proverbs 12:15)?
